### School Closure - Coronavirus (COVID-19)

We are writing to inform you that Dunraven's secondary phase will be partially closed from Wednesday 18 March. **Dunraven's primary phase along with Goldfinch and Van Gogh primary schools will continue to be open as usual for as long as we are able to do so.** We will update you should a change to this situation become necessary. Given the current circumstances, it is *highly likely* that all of our schools will close at some point in the near future. All school visits are postponed until further notice.

Families of children where there are underlying medical conditions, and who are therefore more vulnerable, should decide whether the children are better working from home at present. A reminder that the new guidance is for households to self-isolate for a period of 14 days where a member of the family shows either of the symptoms (e.g. temperature or new persistent cough).

We will update you on any developments as soon as we can via email, text, website and twitter as appropriate. The most important thing is that students and staff are kept safe and we limit the number of those contracting the virus as far as is possible. We are also aware that announcements from central government may force quicker decisions than we had intended to make regarding school closure.

In the meantime, should you have any questions please email the school '@info' address at your child's school and we will respond as soon as possible. We know that this is a challenging time and we will continue to do our best to provide all the support that we can for our children.
