Check out this amazing e-book library filled with fantastic range of books. Your child will receive their username/password with their reports. Please take some time to go through the tutorial to familiarise yourself. When your child logs in for the very first time, they are prompted to take an 'initial quiz', this then helps the programme and recommend texts that are relevant and appropriate for their reading level.

They have the option to search for books that they are interested in within that level; any genre or even non-fiction texts. After they have read a book, they have the option to take a quiz. The quiz shows how well they have understood the text. Each successfully passed quiz gives will give them points and raises their achievement level.
