










NURSERY NEWSLETTER

Topic: Changes

<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development.</p>		<p>This week the children continued talking about change. They continued teaching their friends new tricks, like walking on stilts and used puppets to demonstrate what they can now do. They children also talked about being friends with everybody.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>		<p>The children practised gymnastics and ball games during their PE lessons. They practiced their scissor control by cutting out pictures too.</p>
<p>Communication and Language</p>		<p>This week the children talked, organized and sequenced pictures of the story of The Ugly Duckling. They also talked about their costumes and the story their character is from.</p>
<p>Numeracy</p>		<p>The children learnt to compare two sets of objects to say when the amount is the same/ different. They also learnt to say which amount is smaller/ bigger. The children separated a group of objects in different ways and checked how the amounts are arranged on the dice.</p>
<p>Literacy</p>		<p>The children wrote the story of The Ugly Duckling. They listened for the initial sounds when writing. They also wrote about the character from the story they were dressed up as.</p>
<p>Art and Design</p>		<p>The children helped to decorate our classroom door. They painted little ducklings and the ugly duckling and wrote the labels. The children also made up their own dances and music using various musical instruments. They also enjoyed the music session with our music teacher.</p>
<p>Understanding the World</p>		<p>The children talked about differences and changes. Outside they made playdough using ingredients and talked about how the ingredients. Inside they took part in the making process for pancakes and observed and commented on the changes.</p>
<p>Homework</p>		<p>Next week we will be learning about the lifecycle of butterfly. For homework children will draw a picture of a butterfly and bring it to school to share with their friends.</p>
