<p><b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development.</b></p>		<p>This week the children were learning what we use parts of our body for – hands are for.... feet are for... The children also listened to their talk partners and were able to say who their talk partners are.</p>
<p><b>Physical Development</b></p>		<p>The children love the outdoors. This week amongst the other activities the focus was to move the large community blocks around safely and build a house using them. The children also enjoyed the PE session with our PE teacher. They practised throwing and catching balls and organising coloured cones into groups.</p>
<p><b>Communication and Language</b></p>		<p>This week the children talked about what their house looks like, what their room looks like. They talked to their talking partners during the carpet time and reported back what their partner said to the teacher.</p>
<p><b>Numeracy</b></p>		<p>The children looked for numbers on doors, thought of the number on their own door and found the same number from a group of numbers.</p>
<p><b>Literacy</b></p>		<p>The children continued listening to a range of stories and shared books with their friends. Some children enjoyed reading books to puppets toys in our book area.</p>
<p><b>Art and Design</b></p>		<p>The children enjoyed learning singing nursery rhymes and joining in singing during the music session. They also painted their houses and their bedrooms.</p>
<p><b>Understanding the World</b></p>		<p>The children looked at pictures of different houses in the world and used 3D shapes to build their own houses.</p>
