











**NURSERY NEWSLETTER**

<p><b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development.</b></p>		<p>This week the children enjoyed learning simple playground games, for example What`s the time Mr Wolf. They also played building games with focus on taking turns. The children practised the rules that we have while learning as a group on the carpet.</p>
<p><b>Physical Development</b></p>		<p>The children practised ball skills and followed obstacles, walked along a line placed on the floor. They particularly liked the running games we played. The children also enjoyed taking part in the PE session, learning to respond to sports instructions as well as kick a large ball.</p>
<p><b>Communication and Language</b></p>		<p>The children practised their attention skills during our carpet times. They practised sitting in a circle and enjoyed talking about their favourite food. They also talked about the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar. The children also practised to stay focused while listening to a story or working in a small group.</p>
<p><b>Numeracy</b></p>		<p>The children practised their counting skills. They counted different counters, leaves, fruit, and vegetables, etc. The children also practised their sorting skills.</p>
<p><b>Literacy</b></p>		<p>The children liked listening and joining in stories. This week it was The Very Hungry Caterpillar. The children described their favourite parts of the story. The children also talked about the correct way to hold a book and the correct way to turn pages.</p>
<p><b>Art and Design</b></p>		<p>The children painted pictures of their own choice and pictures of their favourite food. They enjoyed manipulating with playdough too. The children also took part in the music lesson practising playing various musical instruments to the beat.</p>
<p><b>Understanding the World</b></p>		<p>The children made butter and honey sandwiches. They talked about the process and then the taste.</p>
<p><b>Homework</b></p>		<p>We are creating a display of the children when they were babies.
