Personal, Social and Emotional Development.		This week the children talked about change. They taught their friends how to walk on stilts and used puppets to
	77	demonstrate what they can now do.
Physical Development		The children continued enjoying gymnastics lessons and ball games. They practiced changing clothes on the dolls outdoors and change into dress up clothes for role play.
Communication and Language	***	This week the children talked, organized and sequenced pictures. They sequenced growth pictures of members of family and talked about it with their friends.
Numeracy	1 3	The children learnt to measure height and length this week. They marked the height of each other using chalk against the blackboard and talked about how tall they were. Some children decided to measure their height using blocks. Indoors the children worked in groups measuring how long they were using hands, feet and blocks. Then they recorded their findings on the white board.
Literacy	Sec.	The children wrote and drew pictures of their families and practised writing their names. They also wrote about how they made pancakes. They also wrote labelled classroom displays.
Art and Design		The children painted pictures of themselves when they were babies and pictures of themselves now and discussed how they changed. The children also enjoyed music sessions with our music teacher.
Understanding the World		The children talked about differences and changes. Outside they made playdough using ingredients and talked about how the ingredients. Inside they took part in the making process for pancakes and observed and commented on the changes.
