


<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development.</p>		<p>Welcome to all the children and their families to Nursery! This week we have been focusing on settling in, being comfortable in the environment, learning each other's names and where things go.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>		<p>The children enjoyed the outdoors and their first PE session. They showed their climbing and running skills. In the playground the children had lots of opportunities to explore the new playground and its different areas. The climbing frames were the most popular.</p>
<p>Communication and Language</p>		<p>The children played lots of listening games, rhymes and songs and began to learn to listen to their friends. They compare big people and little babies and talked about the differences. The children were encouraged to name objects and speak in sentences.</p>
<p>Numeracy</p>		<p>This week the children sang number songs and used their fingers to show the right number while singing. They also counted blocks they used to built their house using 1:1 correspondence.</p>
<p>Literacy</p>		<p>The children enjoyed reading books about babies and talking about them. They also sang songs about families, e.g., Daddy finger, daddy finger... They also drew pictures of themselves and wrote their names.</p>
<p>Art and Design</p>		<p>The children painted pictures of themselves using "Picasso" style. They learned about an artist called Picasso and talked about some of his famous paintings.</p>
<p>Understanding the World</p>		<p>The children talked about their families and their homes. They enjoyed sharing information about babies, their needs and habits. The children were the experts on the baby subject!</p>
