


NURSERY NEWSLETTER

<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development.</p>		<p>This week the children used puppets to talk about what food they like and how it makes them feel. The children talked to their friends about what food their mum cooks at home for breakfast, lunch and dinner.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>		<p>The children used the community blocks to build a large vegetable patch. In the mud kitchen they were cutting some vegetables and moved big pots of mud from the mud pit to the table to prepare delicious food. The children also enjoyed a PE session where they practised ball skills.</p>
<p>Communication and Language</p>		<p>The children talked about the food they read about in a book and shared books about food with their friends. The children also talked about the vegetables they tasted and the vegetable soup they had cooked.</p>
<p>Numeracy</p>		<p>This week the children counted how many potatoes fit into numicon frames and looked for the corresponding numbers. They also enjoyed weighing vegetables and discussed which one is heavy and which one is light.</p>
<p>Literacy</p>		<p>In phonics the children continued listening for words in sentences. They also thought of their own sentences for their friends to shout out the words.</p>
<p>Art and Design</p>		<p>The children continued their weekly singing sessions with the music teacher. They listened to an orchestra and joined in with playing the music.</p>
<p>Understanding the World</p>		<p>In understanding of the world, the children learnt about different vegetables and where they come from. The children also enjoyed digging for different vegetables in the sand pit.</p>
<p>Homework</p>		<p>For homework find a real potato, design a potato man and bring it to school for our supertato display.</p>
