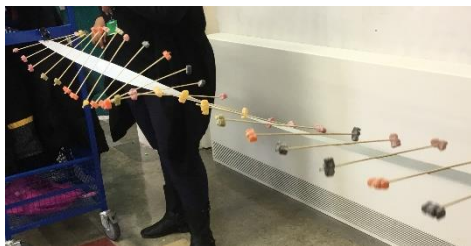


Maths: In maths we have been focusing on our timetables. This is such an important aspect of multiplication and division as we are moving onto the topic soon!
