English: In English we have been investigating the life of Boudicca and her rebellion against the Romans in 61AD. We have also been learning about direct and reported speech to use in our own newspaper articles about Boudicca's uprising.



Maths: In Maths, we have been learning about multiplication and what happens to numbers when we multiply and divide by 10 or 100.



Topic – I am Warrior: In science the year 4s have continued to learn about how sound is made and how we hear sounds. We have also learnt about amplitude (how loud or quiet a sound is) and pitch (how high or low a sound is). In Geography year 4 have been using 4 figure grid references to identify famous landmarks in Rome.
