



COVID-19 Addendum to Goldfinch Primary Behaviour Policy.

This addendum is to be used alongside and in conjunction with our Behaviour Policy. The rationale behind its creation is to ensure the pupils and staff at Goldfinch Primary act in a manner that fully supports the safety measures during the COVID-19 pandemic and national crisis.

Some behaviour concerns referred to in this addendum may previously have been deemed less serious however, if an action now results in the potential compromising of a person's ability to socially distance and stay safe, it will now need immediate action and careful management to ensure both children and staff are kept safe.

3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Choosing to not follow new school routine for arrival and departure despite constant reminders from staff ▪ Not following any 'rule' included in the <u>class charter</u> despite constant reminders from staff ▪ Not following social distancing guidance when lining up or when seated in the classroom despite being given support to do this ▪ Not moving around the school as per the instructions and guidance given despite being given support to do this ▪ Deliberately tampering or touching another child's equipment ▪ Deliberately tampering with cleaning materials such as soap or sanitiser ▪ Deliberately tampering with bins or contents of bins ▪ Deliberately entering an area that is out of bounds and which may compromise the health and safety of children and staff in another group ▪ Deliberately attempting to socialise with members from another group ▪ Deliberately misusing toilet areas and facilities 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The child will be sent home immediately and a risk assessment / decision made about when the child can return to school e.g. day exclusion. ▪ Recorded on 'Behaviour Watch' including brief family contact meeting notes.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Deliberately coughing or spitting at someone. ▪ Any action that would require restraint would compromise staff's ability to be able to distance themselves safely from the child. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The child will be sent home immediately and a risk assessment / decision made to determine if the child can return to school. ▪ Recorded on 'Behaviour Watch' including brief family contact meeting notes.
